THE BODY AND AROMA OF CHRIST

What a great Harvest Fest we had last week! Thank you to all of you who made it a success! What a blessing to be able to celebrate so many new members of the body of Christ at Jenks Avenue this year!

"Body of Christ." It is a rich metaphor for the church. Another profound image of the church in the New Testament is the "aroma" of Christ from 2 Corinthians 2:15.

"For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing." 2 Corinthians 2:15 (NIV)

The "body of Christ" as "aroma of Christ" is not a reference to body odor! It refers to something much deeper.

For ancient people, especially the Jews, sacrifices in the temple were accompanied by a particular aroma. In Exodus 30 a very special mixture of spices and oil was made to anoint priests making sacrifices in the tabernacle (temple). It was so important to God that the Israelites smelled this exact scent and thought about their temple sacrifices that he said.

"Whoever makes perfume like it and puts it on anyone other than a priest must be cut off from their people." **Exodus 30:33**

The sensory experience for the Israelites must have been pretty serious! The obedience of following God's instructions for worship was so important that it was "a pleasing aroma to Jehovah!" (Exodus 29:25)

When we consider the church as the "aroma of Christ to God." it means when we live our lives in obedience to God we imitate Jesus's self-sacrificial love for others. We actually radiate Jesus's sacrificial death for the lost. Like Jesus, the church and all her members are called to be the particular "aroma" of Jesus's sacrifice for the sake of the world - an aroma that's pleasing to our God!
