As we're approaching the last part of the month, our study on Living God's Mission is nearing its end. This isn't a troubled marriages event. This is a marriage improvement event. If you're married and have an interest in making your relationship stronger, this class will work. Heidi and I have been through this class as students, and we use these skills regularly.

This isn't a one-sided conversation about marriage. This is hands on, real talk, tough issues, looking your spouse in the eyes and building something together that you can use.




