Living the King's Hospitality, like everything else we do, is a lifestyle. The church in Acts 2 met in each-others' homes – every day! It's so easy to crowd our schedules so full that we feel like we don't have time for other people. Certainly, there are seasons when each of us is busier than other times. But what if, in your home, you designated one evening-a-week to have someone in your house for a meal, or dessert, or games. If 200 of the 225 households in our church did this twice a month, that would be roughly 5,000 meals shared with others. (don't worry, I used a calculator). If each of these fellowship times lasted just two hours, that would be 10,000 hours of hospitality time right there. What kind of impact would that have on our Mission!? Every day like the church in Acts 2 might be too ambitious right now. But maybe just one night a week, or twice a month would be a more manageable way to begin. How can we make simple hospitality a regular part of our lifestyle?
