WELL, YOU KNOW WHAT THEY SAY...

Whenever I visited my grandparents, my grandpa always had this little notebook that he kept, and in it he would write down phrases that he heard. Over the course of decades, he would collect thousands of idioms from the English language. It was always my goal to try and find one that he hadn't gotten, but it was impossible!

It's really interesting how much we use idioms and "nonsensical" phrases to communicate in America. The phrases we use must make people dizzy who have English as their second language! "It's like shooting fish in a barrel." What? Why are you shooting fish, and why are they in a barrel in the first place? It's interesting how much culture shapes the language that we use, without realizing it!

While Jesus doesn't use English idioms in the way that we think of them, he did use a lot of metaphors and similes as a way to communicate truth. Jesus says, "I am the bread of life," from John 6:35, or, "I am the good shepherd," from John 10:11. It's easy to take these for granted because we're used to reading the Bible and understanding its language.

With how easy it is for idioms to make their way into our speech, I wonder, is it just as easy for us to use language we see from the Bible? It would be interesting to see a chart of all of the different things we say on a day-to-day basis. How much of that would be the type of language that Jesus would use?

We should make an effort to be mindful of the way we speak! Like Jesus says in Matthew 15:11, "It is not what goes into the mouth that defiles a person, but what comes out of the mouth; this defiles a person."


