

SNOWFLAKE SIMPLICITY

In 1885 Wilson Bentley first photographed a single snowflake. He did it by adapting the lens of an old microscope so he could isolate the snowflake on a black background, allowing him to capture an image of it. He did all of that at only 19 years old! He would continue to capture pictures of snowflakes using various research grants over the next 47 years. During those years, Bentley photographed 5,381 snowflakes. Near the end of his life, he made a claim that has now become somewhat of a household anecdote: no two snowflakes that he photographed were the same. He said, “Under the microscope, I found that snowflakes were miracles of beauty. Every crystal was a masterpiece of design and no one design was ever repeated.” To this day science has not proven his theory false! Whether it was intentional or not, Bentley’s discovery heavily implied the existence of a Creator.

When you think about every single snowflake that has ever fallen, and of all the snow that sits on the earth right now, the weight of this discovery becomes even more dizzying. There’s one thing I can’t help but think – if God takes that much care for snow, how much more does he care for me? Jesus relays this same sentiment in Matthew 6 when talking about the lilies of the field. He says that not even Solomon, with all the wealth in the world, was clothed as beautifully as they were. The same God that made the snow and the lilies loved us enough to make us in his image. What an honor, and what an encouragement! Snowflakes melt in your hand in the blink of an eye, and flowers wilt after a season. But God has made it so that we can live with him for eternity!

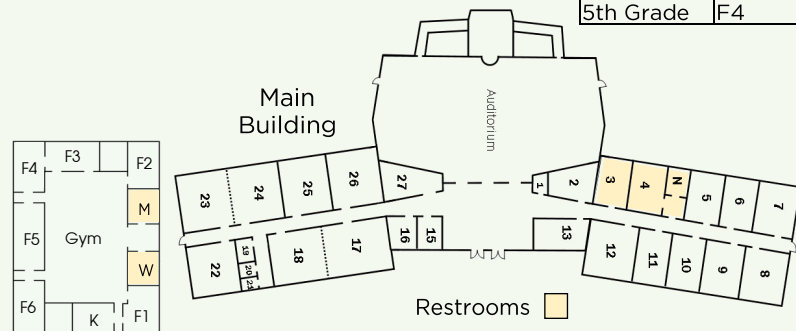
