## HAPPY BIRTHDAY JENKS AVE

On Thursday, April 3 our congregation reached its 70th anniversary! In the early 1950's a national spiritual fervor led to a global explosion of growth for churches of Christ. On Sunday, April 3, 1955 fifty-three members of Palo Alto church of Christ, lead by Gerald McCalister and Gil Wilson (Suzanne Witham's dad), began meeting in the St. Andrew Elementary School. The following year, Palo Alto purchased a small piece of land on Beck Avenue and deeded the land to the new St. Andrew congregation. In those early days, Wilson and McCalister took turns preaching.

From 1955 to 1973, eight different men preached for the young church. The last in that string of preachers, Hugh Tucker (also a Bay County school teacher), jokingly remembers being tasked with finding a new preacher for the church – which resulted in Jack and Pam Reece moving to Panama City with their infant son, Todd, in July 1973.

Jack's love and patience for the church and his focus on God's word and unity, coupled with Gil Wilson's penchant for pushing people to do more and reach beyond themselves, led the church to outgrow the building on Beck Avenue. In 1984, the Beck Ave. church of Christ purchased land on Jenks Avenue. And on July 18, 1993 the Beck Ave. congregation officially moved to Jenks Avenue and became the Jenks Ave. church of Christ.

God has blessed us richly over the last 70 years with strong, godly leaders, a high level of church involvement, an unwavering commit-

ment to "...the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace." (Ephesians 4:3) As we keep looking forward, outward and upward, and bring more souls before God's throne, may we display the same spiritual fervor that has kept our eyes on Jesus - and may God's Holy Spirit guide our next 70 years!




