Do I love it enough to tell people about it? Do I love it so much that I'm eager to bring more to experience it with me?

Acts 1:8 says, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." That's where we live, at the end of the earth. If you're in Christ, then you have the Holy Spirit upon you and this message is for you.

It's pretty easy to fall into the trap of really being blessed by this body of believers without feeling an urgency to let other people in on the blessing.

Here's the thing, what's good for the goose is good for the gander, so get out there you silly geese and bring those ganders to church. (I don't know what a gander is, but I'm pretty sure I nailed it.)

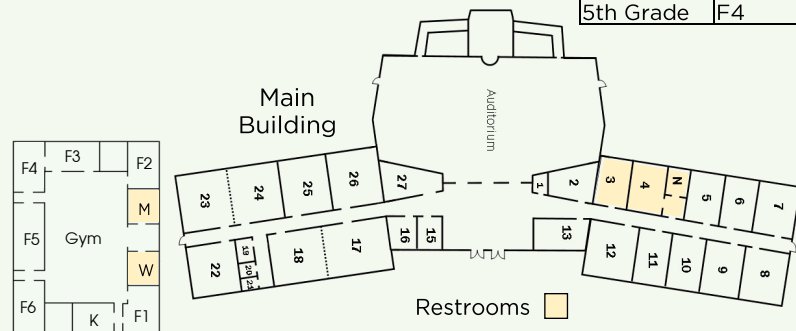
