I really like the mystery genre. There's something frustratingly satisfying about laboring through a movie or book to finally figure out who did it... or did they? That's the frustrating part. In some cases the book ends, the curtains close, and you're left still unsure about what just happened. There is one book like this that stuck with me in that way, *Sphere*, by Michael Crichton. It's technically a sci-fi book, but the premise is some unknown alien technology is found at the bottom of the sea, and a research team goes down to investigate. Through the course of the book, weird things start happening, and you're unsure the entire time what is real and what is just in their heads. The book ends this way as well, with one of the characters giving the final line, leaving you wondering. Did they separate fully from the technology? Did one of them take it for their own? I once had a full-scale debate about the ending with someone!

There are plenty of uncertainties in life. Things that drain our confidence. God is not one of them. Hebrews 4 establishes that Christ has been made as a mediator for us, our spiritual high priest. Not a high priest who is "holier than thou," or disconnected from the people, but one who can relate to us and to God just as we need. Because of this, it says in verse 16, "Let us then **with confidence** draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." God is not distant and unreachable, and we don't need to be concerned about our standing. We have a Great High Priest who graciously allows us to draw near to Him!

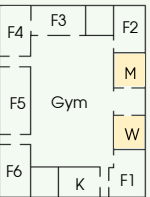

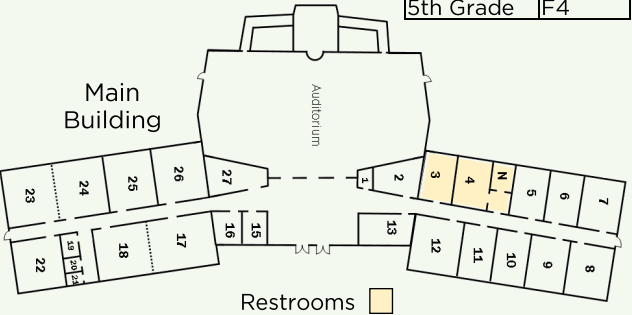
