# SIGNS OF MARRIAGE TROUBLE

Healthy marriage takes work, time, investment, grace, and faith. I read an article recently that listed seven signs that a marriage is struggling. If any of these signs applies to you or your marriage, please read the end of this article!

- 1. Seriousness Healthy marriages are playful, when you feel safe and genuinely enjoy each other. Without joking and laughing, being married is more like being coworkers than friends or lovers.
- 2. Separation It's good to have some separate activities (hobbies, movies, etc.) However if separation becomes the norm, this signals trouble. Separating finances, sleep, etc. moves a couple farther away from each other.
- 3. Bitterness When you ruminate on hurtful words or actions instead of dealing with them, this leads to growing bitterness. When bitterness takes root, it leads to resentment and contempt.
- 4. Suspicion Trust is implied in being married. When one spouse has a growing suspicion about what the other spouse is saying or doing, this spells trouble.
- 5. Secrets Some jobs require confidentiality. Aside from that, when you regularly keep secrets from each other, or if you are doing things you wouldn't want your spouse to know about, this is a signal of deep problems.
- 6. Apathy If you lose the desire to work on your marriage, your marriage is in trouble. It indicates you are not emotionally engaged with each other.
- 7. Contempt Feelings of bitterness and hostility toward each other is a huge, critical red flag and the biggest sign of a marriage headed for disaster.


