

FIVE QUESTIONS FOR 2026

Last week, our lesson on Sunday morning came from Matthew 4:19. Jesus calls his people to follow him. From that text, and observing the first disciples, we drew out five questions to ask ourselves at the start of a new year. These questions can challenge us to make specific, manageable changes to follow Jesus better.

After church last Sunday, our family sat around the table and discussed each of these questions and how we might improve in these areas. I was encouraged by how each of us processed these questions and their implications differently. And I was challenged to make deeper commitments this year. It was a rich discussion and one I recommend for all of us.

The five questions are listed below. I want to challenge you, if you haven't already, to sit down with a friend, a group, or your family, and talk through these questions. For each question, list one or two tangible, measurable, and specific goals, habits, or changes you want to make this year to better follow Jesus where he is leading you in 2026.

1. How can I learn to trust Jesus better this year?
2. What do I need to let go of this year?
3. How can I invest in the church better this year?
4. What is one way I can serve others better this year?
5. How can I pay better attention to Jesus this year?

May we all pursue Jesus more eagerly and follow him out into the world where he is already at work, changing the lives of people. May we be disciples committed to intentionally making more disciples for Jesus.
