Let our hearts embrace God’s work in us. “For it is God who works in you, both to will and to work his good pleasure” (Philippians 2:13). Let us all truly follow Him—live as He lived, do as He did, and become like Him.

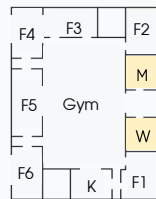

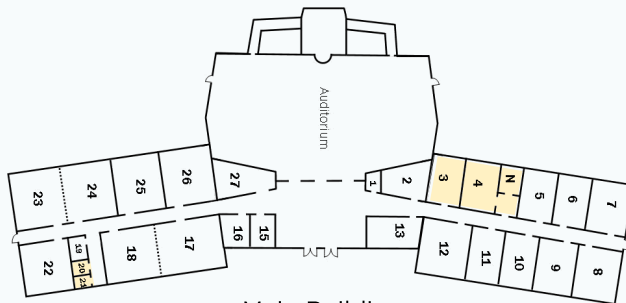

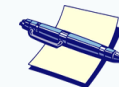
