

WHY BE BAPTIZED?

We have been talking about baptism. I will never forget a simple sermon brother Jack preached in 1998.

First, he told the story of the Israelites in Joshua 6 whom God told to march around the city of Jericho. Then, they were to blow their trumpets and shout. They marched, blew, and shouted and the walls of the great city came crashing down. Brother Jack asked, "Why march, blow, and shout?" The simple answer was, because God told them to march, blow and shout.

He then told the story of Namaan the leper from 2 Kings 5. Namaan, a Syrian commander, had contracted incurable leprosy. A Jewish slave girl, stolen from her family, told him about the prophet Elisha who could heal him. Namaan traveled to see Elisha and was told to dip in the Jordan River seven times. He didn't want to, but he tried it and was healed. Brother Jack asked, "Why dip?" The simple answer was, because God told him to dip.

Finally, brother Jack told the story of the man in John 9 who had been born blind. Jesus spit in the dirt, put mud on his eyes and told him to go wash in the pool of Siloam. He did it and came away from the pool being able to see for the first time in his life! Brother Jack asked, "Why wash?" The simple answer was, because God told him to wash.

So, why should we be baptized?

God told Israel to march, blow, and shout, Namaan to dip, and the blind man to wash. And He rewarded their obedience.

So, when the Son of God tells us to be baptized, why should we do it? Could it be so simple? Because God told us to. God rewards obedience. Personally, that's good enough for me.

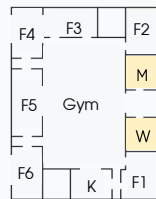

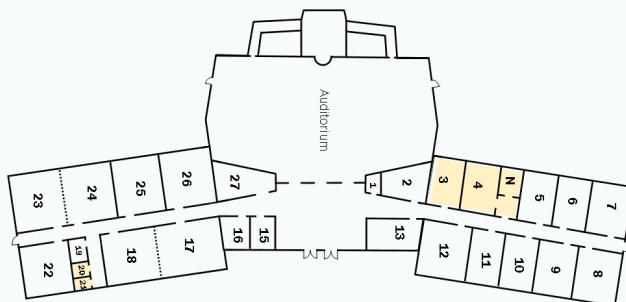
