[why we go]

In light of last week's sermon, and this afternoon's small group discussion, I am convicted that our place in this world is to be unsettled, compelled, and uprooted. The people of God have not been a particularly stagnant people at

any time in their history. God has moved his people, not emotionally or spiritually, but physically. God sent Adam and Eve from the only home they'd ever known after they defied his commands. He sent Noah across the sea to a land that he'd never seen before. God asked Abraham to leave his homeland without knowing where he'd end up. God took Isaac, the son of promise, off into a foreign land. He took Joseph into Egypt. He led Moses into, and later out of, Egypt. Daniel, Ruth, David, Elijah, Esther, Paul, the Apostles, Mary and Joseph, Jesus.

You'd have a hard time naming a prominent figure of the Bible who wasn't uprooted, or relocated, or compelled to literally move in service of God. God's people have been a people on the move. They've been a people with a calling, and a purpose. They've been forced out. They've been called out. They've been sent out.

We, too, have been sent. The church is not waiting to be picked up for delivery, we are sent. Past tense. Already. Sent.

In Acts 1, after the resurrection and moments before the ascension of Jesus, he says these words:

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the Earth.

-Acts 1:8

Perhaps you've heard the well-known quote by Spiderman's Uncle Ben, "With great power comes great responsibility." We've been given great power, and we've been sent.




