Hey Jenks Avenue! This Friday, April 3, our congregation will officially be 71 years old!


I recently learned about the history of the hymn "Faith of Our Fathers," written in 1849 to remember the death of Christian martyrs in the past who experienced persecution for the sake of the gospel. I am always struck by the words in the chorus, "...we will be true to thee 'til death." Our true commitment is to Christ, but it extends to Christ's people. In this hymn we remember the high price many have paid to hold onto and preserve the gospel, and pass it on to future generations.

Those who started our congregation on Sunday, April 3, 1955, didn't die for the gospel, but they did realize that Christ commissioned the church to multiply. They didn't leave Eastside or Palo Alto and start meeting in St. Andrews because they were dissatisfied with their fellowship or the teaching. They did it so they could spread the gospel in a different area of town, so that more people could hear the gospel. What faith and what commitment!

The writer of Hebrews instructs, "Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith." (Heb. 13:7). Our lives are different. Our culture is different. Our location is different. We can't imitate everything about those early years of our congregation. But we can remember their lives and what came from them, appreciate their investment in God's mission, and honor their commitment by imitating their faith.

May we honor those who've gone before us. Thank you for starting this congregation so that we may reap the benefits of the gospel and pass their missional fervor on to future generations!


