

NEW LIFE

This is Jane, our Jane Magnolia tree we planted last fall. When the weather got cold in December, and froze in January and February, Jane's leaves fell off and we thought she was dead – not winter dead, but like dead-dead. She looked like the antler on top of the Grinch's dog, Max. We lost seven oaks in Hurricane Michael, and we aren't good at growing trees (we've lost a lot of trees through the years). So, we know what a dead tree looks like – and Jane had "the look."

But...Jane's illness didn't end in death. Instead, the air got warmer and the sun started shining a little longer. And like Samson's hair in prison (Judges 16:21-22), Jane began to push out some little buds. The next day there was a full-fledged flower! And two days later, Jane was a real, living tree!

I can't image how the people in Bethany felt when Lazarus, four days buried, came shuffling out of the crypt, still wrapped in his grave clothes (John 11:44). Hearing that Lazarus was sick, Jesus had told his disciples that his illness would not end in death (11:4). But then Lazarus died, and everyone knew it. Like our experience with trees, they had seen what death looks like many times – Lazarus was dead. Even Jesus acknowledged that he had died (11:14). But Jesus had other plans, and, to the glory of God, he brought life from death!

This season, as newness springs from what we thought was dead, let's not give up on our neighbors. Some may seem beyond the gospel's reach, but Jesus has other plans. As long as there is life, there is hope that their illness will not end in death. Keep sharing Christ because he still brings life from the tomb – to the glory of God!

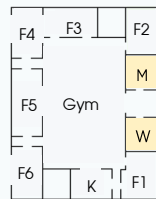
Children are dropped off in rm 23 between 5:50-6:00 p.m. and picked up between 7:00-7:10 p.m.

Children must be signed in and out by a parent.

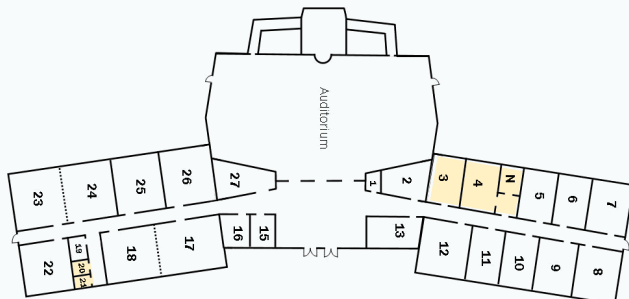
