

RIGHTEOUSNESS

What do you think about when you hear the word **righteousness**? Webster defines it as “the quality or state of being righteous: conformity to the divine or the moral law: Uprightness.” Acting right.

Righteous refers to behaving in a morally correct way or being considered morally right. It encompasses actions and individuals who are just, virtuous, and in alignment with divine or moral law.

In Matthew 5:20, in the sermon on the mount, Jesus tells the people he hasn't come to abolish the law or prophets but to fulfill them, and that we need to keep God's commandments. Jesus says, “For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven.”

Jesus is telling us we need to live a righteous life. That we need to do what is right, even when it is difficult. He expects this of us. This can be a difficult thing sometimes, because satan is always lurking around seeking whom he may devour. He not only knows our weaknesses, but he knows when we are weak and struggling. He also knows how to tempt us. We must be strong!

When we fall, we must get back up, repent, and strive to do better. We know we have forgiveness in Jesus and our strength is in him. That's why Paul tells us in Ephesians 6:10-20 to keep the faith and put on the full armor of God: the belt of truth (Jesus), the breastplate of righteousness (Jesus), the gospel of peace (Jesus), the shield of faith (Jesus), helmet of salvation (Jesus), and the sword of the Spirit - the Word of God (Jesus). Let Jesus surround and fill you.

With Jesus and the Holy Spirit you can be righteous.
